



Pingyao Folk Tour – Private Tour - 3 Days

This 3-day tour will let you discover Pingyao - one of the most famous ancient towns in China. You will admire the remarkable architecture and artworks in the Chang Family Compound, and wander in the Liang Village, a well-preserved and remote ancient village.

240-Hour Visa-Free Transit in China

China is implementing a 10-day (240 hours) visa-free transit policy. The transit program allows visitors who have existing flight bookings from China to a third country (region) to snag a visa on arrival at a Chinese airport (port) and stay for 10 days before departure. Hong Kong, Macao and Taiwan all count as third destinations.

Passport holders of 54 countries, including the United States and the United Kingdom, can enter visa-free through any of the 60 open airports (ports) in 24 provincial regions, covering popular tourist cities like Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an, Chengdu and Guangzhou.

1	Day 1 Pingyao	 train station transfer in Pingyao  Liang Village The Liang Village is a well-preserved and remote ancient village, located 6 kilometers southwest of Pingyao. The village consists of about 130 traditional courtyards with finest examples of brick carving and wood carving of the Qing Dynasty.
2	Day 2 Pingyao	 breakfast, lunch  Ancient City of Pingyao The Ancient City of Pingyao (UNESCO), a well-preserved ancient Chinese city of the Ming and Qing Dynasties, is a must-see attraction for you. You will admire the Ancient City Wall built with bricks and stones. Approach to Rishengchang Bank - the first bank of China, and get impressed by the Old Government Buildings. The courtyard houses, narrow streets and small shops in the city provide a complete picture of China's cultural and social lifestyle during that period of time.

3	Day 3 Pingyao	 train station transfer in Pingyao  breakfast  Chang Family Compound The Chang Family Compound is a witness to the past glory of Chang Family, a well-known Shanxi businessman in the Qing Dynasty. The complex boasts remarkable architecture and artworks of brick and stone sculptures. Service ends.
