1	Day 1 Datong	 airport-hotel transfer in Datong
2	Day 2 Datong - Mount Wutai (by automobile)	 private transfer from Datong to Mt. Wutai  breakfast, lunch  Yungang Grottoes, Hanging Temple The Yungang Grottoes is the oldest one of the Three Major Buddhist Grottoes of China. Absorbing Indian Gandhara Buddhist art, Yungang Grottoes melds traditional Chinese art and social features of that time, which make it a masterpiece of early Chinese cave art and Buddhist culture. Built more than 1,500 years ago, the Hanging Temple is characterized by its special location on the sheer cliff and its combination of Buddhism, Taoism and Confucianism.
3	Day 3 Mount Wutai	 breakfast, lunch  Mount Wutai Enjoy an exploration to Mount Wutai (UNESCO), one of the Four Sacred Buddhist Mountains in China. It is home to 47 China's most important monasteries, among which the Xiantong Temple and the Tayuan Temple are the most famous ones.
4	Day 4 Mount Wutai - Datong (by automobile)	 private transfer from Mt. Wutai to Datong, airport or train station transfer in Datong  breakfast, lunch  Yingxian Wooden Pagoda The Wooden Pagoda ranks as the oldest and highest wooden structure in China. It was built without any nails or rivets, which represents a perfect combination of science, art and religion. Service ends.
