

## Grassland & Desert Adventure of Inner Mongolia - 4 Days

This tour highlights the stunning grasslands and the Gobi Desert in Inner Mongolia. You could ride horse on the Gegentala Grassland; enjoy a campfire party in the evening and sunrise in the early morning; try camel riding and thrilling sand sliding in the Kubuqi Desert.

| 1    | Day 1 Hohhot  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>airport-hotel transfer in Hohhot</li><li>private transfer from Hohhot to grasslands</li><li>breakfast, lunch</li><li>Today, take a car ride from Hohhot to the <b>Gegentala Grassland</b> (about 2.5 hours). Gegentala Grassland is the largest and a unique area featuring fascinating scenery and Inner Mongolia ethical culture.</li></ul>  |
| 2    | Day 2 Hohhot - grasslands (by automobile)                       | <p>On arrival, you could take an optional tour to visit a <b>Herdman's family</b> and <b>Aobao Hill</b> or enjoy your free time in the grassland. (All the optional activities, such as horse riding, are at your own expenses)</p> <p><b>Overnight in Mongolian yurt (with twin beds and private wash room)</b></p> <p><b>Good to know:</b> There are three famous grasslands near Hohhot, including Xilamuren Grassland (140 km), Huitengxile Grassland (140 km) and Gegentala Grassland (190 km). The itinerary could be tailor-made according to your preference.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>private transfer of Grasslands/Resonant Sand Gorge/Baotou</li><li>breakfast, lunch</li><li>In the morning, watch the amazing sunrise in the grassland.</li></ul> <p>Then take a car ride to the Kubuqi Desert, China's seventh largest desert (about 3.5hours). Pass the Yellow River Bridge en route.</p> |
| 3    | Day 3 Grasslands - Resonant Sand Gorge - Baotou (by automobile) | <p>On arrival, take a visit to the <b>Resonant Sand Gorge</b>. Located at the east of the Kubqi Desert, the Resonant Sand Gorge (also called Resonant Sand Bay) has a dune rising up to 90 meters high with a slope of about 45 degrees. When you climb to its summit and slide down, the sound will be so loud that you might feel as if the dune is trembling.</p> <p>You could try camel-riding or sand sliding at your own expense.</p> <p>Later, drive to Baotou city (about 1.5 hours) and transfer to the hotel.</p>  |
| 4    | Day 4 Baotou  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>airport transfer in Baotou</li><li>breakfast</li></ul>   |
