Urumqi features the Xinjiang Museum, Heavenly Lake, and the Grand Bazaar, while Turpan boasts the Jiaohe Ancient City, Karez Irrigation System, Sugong Pagoda, Bezeklik Thousand Buddha Caves, and the ruins of Gaochang City. These sites showcase rich history and culture, making them excellent choices for exploring the charm and civilization of Xinjiang.

1	Day 1 Urumqi	 airport-hotel transfer in Urumqi  <b>Urumqi International Grand Bazaar</b> Urumqi's International Grand Bazaar is a lively market showcasing Uyghur culture. Visitors can explore colorful stalls selling traditional crafts, spices, and textiles, sample local delicacies, and shop for unique souvenirs. It's a must-visit for an authentic Xinjiang experience.
2	Day 2 Urumqi	 breakfast, lunch  <b>Heavenly Lake, Xinjiang Regional Museum</b> The Heavenly Lake is surrounded by the vastness of mountains and alpine meadows with an elevation of 2000 meters above sea level. The Xinjiang Regional Museum is located in the center of Urumqi, showcasing a rich collection of historical artifacts and culture from Xinjiang. Visitors can explore the history and culture of Xinjiang, admire ancient Silk Road relics, and traditional crafts. It is not only a place for historical exhibits but also a destination to learn about Xinjiang's culture. Welcome to explore the Xinjiang Regional Museum and discover the unique charm of this magical land! Open time: 10:30-18:00. Entry stops after 16:30, and advance booking is required. Closed every Monday.
3	Day 3 Urumqi - Turpan (by automobile)	 private transfer from Urumqi to Turpan  breakfast, lunch  <b>Jiaohe Ruins , Karez System, Emin Minaret</b> The Jiaohe Ruins reveals traces of a prosperous ancient trading center and military base 600 years ago. The Karez System (UNESCO), an underground irrigation system, is considered to be one of the three great ancient projects of China. Its main function is to deliver water from nearby snow capped mountains to Turpan and its agricultural fields. Emin Minaret, also known as Sugong Tower, is one of the most famous Islamic constructions and the only Islamic tower in China.

4	Day4 Turpan	 hotel to the railway station transfer  breakfast  <b>Bazelik Thousand Buddha Caves, Gaochang Ancient Ruins</b> The Bazelik Thousand Buddha Caves has 77 caves and inside each cave is a mural of the Buddha painted on the ceiling along with hundreds of Buddhist sculptures and figures. The Gaochang Ancient Ruins used to be the capital of ancient kingdom Gaochang, which is also the biggest ruins in Xinjiang.

- Leaving from Turpan, you can travel to Dunhuang. But you may need to stay one more night in Turpan and then take a 3.5-hour high-speed train to Dunhuang the next day. You can also head for the airport in Urumqi where there are frequent flights to other cities.
- If you prefer to do further explorations of the Silk Road, you can go from Turpan to Korla, Kuqa, Aksu, Kashgar... please feel free to contact your tour consultant if you want to extend your Xinjiang tour itinerary.
