3	Day 3 Shanghai - Suzhou – Shanghai (by automobile)	<p>Upon arrival, you will visit the Master of Nets Garden (UNESCO), the smallest and most delicate of all the beautiful gardens in Suzhou.</p> <p>Then, learn Chinese calligraphy with other students in a traditional courtyard in Suzhou. Professional teacher will definitely give you an unforgettable time and unique fun in Suzhou!</p> <p>Later, take a short cruise along the Grand Canal. Get on board and voyage on the longest man-made waterway in the world.
