1	Day 1 Kashgar	 airport-hotel transfer in Kashgar
2	Day 2 Kashgar	 breakfast, lunch  <b>Old Town of Kashgar, Id Kah Mosque , Fragrant Concubine Garden</b> Kashgar Old Town, located in Xinjiang, China, is a historic and cultural gem that dates back over 2,000 years. It was built around 3rd century AD, and left about 265 caves today. Kuqa Wensu Grand Canyon is located in Kuqa County, Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region, and is a charming natural landscape. The Grand Canyon is known for its steep canyon terrain, clear streams, and ancient vegetation. Visitors can hike along the canyon, admire the spectacular rock formations, and diverse vegetation. Here, you can experience the grandeur and magnificence of nature, enjoy the fresh air, and tranquil environment. Kuqa Wensu Grand Canyon is an ideal place for outdoor adventures and a paradise for photography enthusiasts. 7	Day 7 Kuqa	 breakfast, lunch  <b>Keziliya Grand Canyon , Subashi Temple</b> Tianshan Grand Canyon, also known as Keziliya Grand Canyon, is a natural wonder located 48 kilometers from Urumqi City. It features lakes, canyons, grasslands, snowy mountains, and an ancient spruce forest. Visitors can experience nomadic life, enjoy activities like boating and hiking, and explore scenic spots such as Tianshui Lake, Green Dragon Bay, and Swan Lake. Subash Buddhist Temple Ruins, also known as Jiasi Daban Monastery, are located 20 kilometers northeast of Kuqa City in Aksu Prefecture, Xinjiang, China. Dating back to the Wei and Jin Dynasties, this site includes a Buddhist pagoda surrounded by temples, caves, halls, and monks' quarters. Well-preserved and split by a river, the ruins are mainly concentrated in the West Temple area.

8	Day 8 Kuqa - Luntai - Korla (by automobile)	 Private transfer Kuqa - Luntai - Korla  breakfast, lunch  <b>Tarim Popular National Forest Park</b> Tarim Populus Euphratica Forest National Park, located in Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region, is famous for its ancient and mysterious Populus Euphratica forest. Visitors can enjoy the majestic trees and unique desert landscapes, making it a great place for nature photography and exploration. A visit to the park offers a chance to appreciate the wonders of nature and create lasting memories of the desert's magical vitality.
9	Day 9 Korla - Urumqi (by air)	 hotel-airport transfer in Korla, airport-hotel transfer in Urumqi  breakfast, lunch  <b>Heavenly Lake</b> The Heavenly Lake is surrounded by the vastness of mountains and alpine meadows with an elevation of 2000 meters above sea level.
